



8th Annual Gently-Used Clothing & Sports Equipment Swap & Sale **Saturday, May 7th**

Drop-Off at the Shafer Park Community Center:
May 3-6 (Tuesday-Friday) 4:30-8pm
May 4 (Wednesday) 9am-12 noon

Here's How It Works:

During the week before the May 7th Boonsboro Green Fest, drop off clean, gently-used clothing of any size (infant- adult) and gently-used sports equipment at the Community Center at the times listed above, and earn a credit for each piece donated. (Please, no clothing with stains, holes, or tears.)

On May 7, take the credit vouchers to the Green Fest swap in Pavilion #1 at Shafer Park and choose an equal number of pieces. Clothing may also be swapped during the Green Fest, but it is preferable that items be received at the Community Center in advance of the Saturday festival.

Clothes should be folded and in bags labeled with the donor's name. Those with nothing to swap may purchase clothing at yard-sale prices. Donation tax receipts are available upon request.

All leftover clothing will be donated to Children in Need, Inc. of Washington County. Last year, more than 8,000 pieces of clothing were donated. All monetary proceeds will be donated to Micah's Backpack (southcountyfoodpantry.org).
