### **Here's how it works**

During the four days prior to the May 13 Green Fest, you may drop off clean, gently-used clothing of any size (infant- adult) and sports equipment of all kinds at the Community Center in Shafer Park and earn a credit for each piece donated. *(Please, no clothing with stains, holes, or tears.)*

On May 13, take the credit vouchers to the Green Fest Swap in Pavilion #1 at Shafer Park

and choose an equal number of pieces. Clothing may also be swapped during the Green Fest, but it is preferable that items be received at the Community Center in advance of the Saturday festival.

Clothes should be folded and in bags labeled with the donor's name. Those with nothing to swap may purchase clothing at yard-sale prices. Donation tax receipts are available upon request.

All leftover clothing will be donated to Children in Need, Inc. of Washington County. Last year, more than 8,000 pieces of clothing were donated. In addition, all monetary proceeds will be donated to Micah's Backpack of Boonsboro, operated by the South County Food Pantry.
